CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE

TOXICS IN PACKAGING LEGISLATION

Dear Dart Customer:

Dart products are sanitary, convenient, and possess high quality. In addition, Dart products are manufactured safely, which means that no heavy metals-lead, mercury, cadmium or hexavalent chromium-are intentionally added to our products, nor is the sum of the concentration levels of these heavy metals, if any are incidentally present, over the stated legal limit of 100 parts per million.

Several states, including yours, have enacted toxics-in-packaging laws modeled on heavy metal concentration limits proposed by the Coalition of Northeastern Governors (CONEG). Such laws require each manufacturer or supplier to furnish a written statement to the purchaser of a package or packaging component stating that such products comply with all CONEG-type limitations with respect to such metals. Therefore, please accept this statement covering all of our products as Dart Container Corporation's certificate of compliance with CONEG-type laws governing toxics in packaging.

Dart Container Corporation hereby certifies that all packaging and packaging components sold to Dart customers and distributors comply with state toxics-in-packaging laws. Specifically:

- 1) Dart certifies that the regulated metals-lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium-were not intentionally added to any Dart package or packaging component during the manufacturing process.*
- 2) Dart further certifies that the sum of the incidental concentration levels of lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium, present in any Dart package or package component does not exceed the legal limit of 100 parts per million by weight.*
- 3) For customers in Iowa only, in compliance with IAC 567-213.5; Dart certifies that no materials were used to replace the regulated metals.*
